

Final March 2019 Economic Forecast

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We have updated the preliminary March economic forecast, which was released on February 26, 2019. The final March economic forecast reflects a more recent national forecast and newly released state employment data. This updated economic forecast will form the basis of the March 2019 revenue forecast scheduled for release on March 20, 2019.

The following tables compare the final March economic forecast with the preliminary March forecast as well as with the forecast adopted in November.
