

## **Revised June 2023 Economic Forecast**

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We have updated our June economic forecast. The revised economic forecast reflects a more recent national economic forecast and another month of employment and unemployment data. This updated economic forecast will form the basis of the June 2023 revenue forecast scheduled for adoption on June 27, 2023.

The following tables compare the revised June economic forecast with the preliminary June forecast as well as with the forecast adopted in March 2023.
